3801 Limited, in association with Hunter Valley Training Company, will operate two steam trips with former **South Maitland Railways Steam Locomotive No.18** during March 2012. This steam loco, together with others of the class, was the backbone of coal movement on the **SMR** lines in the Hunter Valley for almost one hundred years.

On **Sunday 4th March** the train will depart Central at approximately 9:00am* and travel to Carlingford. The train will then go to Sandown briefly before continuing on to Blacktown to join the branch line to Richmond. Here there will be time for a leisurely lunch before the train departs, to arrive at Central around 4:30pm.*
